


# MANDATORY FOR JOURNEYMEN

**All Book 1 and Book 2 Journeymen must annually complete 10 hours of approved journeymen training as a condition of new or **continuing** employment.**

This new requirement is mandated in Section 5.9.1 of the Master Labor Agreement (2017-2026) for the Plumbing and Piping Industry of Southern California between the CPMCA and Southern California Pipe Trades District Council No. 16.

In order to be eligible for employment within the District Council 16 jurisdiction this upgrade training mandate MUST be completed annually by all Journeymen. Members must attend ALL hours of training and pass the course with a 70% or better.

10 hours of training required  
annually

Effective September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020:  
15 hours of training required  
annually

Effective September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022:  
20 hours of training required  
annually
